## Colorado Mountain College (CMC)

### About CMC:

CMC is a local district junior college serving approximately 22,000 students at 11 instructional sites spread across Colorado’s Western Slope.

### Project Scope\*:

LED retrofits at CMC facilities located in Aspen, Glenwood Springs, Carbondale and Spring Valley.

Boiler replacement of an 80% efficient model to a 95% efficient model at the campus in Carbondale.

Upgraded roof insulation at the Glenwood Springs Administration Building.

**Total Project Cost:** \$200,000

**Amount Requested:** \$100,000

**CORE grant amount:** \$75,000

### Energy Savings\*:

74,930 kWh/ year

19,421 Therms/ year

### Resulting Carbon Savings

2,470 tons over their lifetime, equivalent to:

Taking 520 cars off the road or 225 homes off the grid.
