Rocky Mountain Institute (RMI)

About RMI:

Rocky Mountain Institute is a nonprofit organization with a mission to create a clean, prosperous, and secure energy future for the world. This grant will assist RMI in achieving their goals for the Innovation Center: to generate more electricity than it uses, to use no fossil fuels at all, and to use less water than falls on the site. The hope is that it will serve as a living testament to the effectiveness of green building and energy efficiency, act as a living laboratory for the development of new tools and techniques, and embody RMI's mission.

Project Scope*:

The inclusion of LED lights and “Hyperchairs” which allow customized, targeted heating and cooling in office environments.

Total Project Cost: \$147,200

Amount Requested: \$73,600

CORE grant amount: \$25,000

Annual Energy Savings*:

135,240 kWh/ year

4,771 Therms/ year

Resulting Carbon Savings*:

These projects will offset 1,055 tons of carbon over their lifecycle, equivalent to taking 223 cars off the road or 96.3 homes off the grid.
