## **Town of Snowmass Village Creekside Apartments**

**About Creekside:**

The Creekside Apartments comprise 45 units of affordable, for-rent employee housing spread across 5 buildings owned by the Town of Snowmass Village. The Town has embarked on an exterior shell renovation of the entire all electric complex with a focus on reducing energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions. This will be the first of three phases to update 129 \ affordable employee housing units in Snowmass.

**Project Scope\*:**

Efficiency improvements include insulation, air sealing, programmable thermostats and window upgrades.

**Total Project Cost:** \$646,397

**Amount Requested:** \$200,000

**CORE grant amount:** \$75,000

**Annual Energy Savings\*:**

252,310 kWh/ year

**Resulting Carbon Savings\*:**

192 tons of carbon per year, 3,936 tons over the project’s lifetime, equivalent to taking 829 cars off the road or 359 homes off the grid.
