About Anderson Ranch:

Anderson Ranch Arts Center is a nonprofit arts education organization located in Snowmass Village that provides transformative experiences celebrating artists, art making, creative dialogue and community.

Project Scope*:

Replace three inefficient boilers that are at the end of their life expectancy, are a potential safety hazard, and have a energy factor of 80%, with new energy efficient ones with a energy factor of 95%.

Total Project Cost: \$66,445

Amount Requested: \$41,327

CORE grant amount: \$20,000

Annual Energy Savings*:

979 Therms/ year

Carbon Savings*:

5.7 tons of carbon dioxide per year and 114 tons over their lifetime, equivalent to taking 24 cars off the road or 10.4 homes off the grid.
