About City of Aspen:

The City of Aspen strives to be an environmental leader and to promote environmental stewardship throughout the Roaring Fork Valley and around the globe. In an effort to reduce the threat of climate change, Aspen's City Council adopted the City of Aspen's Canary Action Plan in 2007, which commits to reducing community emissions 30% by 2020 and 80% by 2050.

Project Scope*:

The purchase and installation of LED light fixtures at three City buildings including the Red Brick Gymnasium, Lewis Ice Arena and Aspen Ice Garden, which will reduce total lighting load by 27,000 watts in these facilities.

Total Project Cost: \$147,778

Amount Requested: \$75,000

CORE grant amount: \$75,000

Energy Savings*:

117,458 kWh/ year

Carbon Savings*:

89.3 tons of carbon per year or 1,786 tons over their lifetime, equivalent to taking 376 cars off the road or 163 homes off the grid.
