About the Inn at Aspen:

The Inn at Aspen is a condominium hotel built in the late 1960’s at the base of Buttermilk Ski Area.

Project Scope*:

This grant will support the HOA’s replacement of existing fluorescent and incandescent light fixtures with new LED light fixtures and lamps throughout the common areas of the facility.

Total Project Cost: \$50,780

Amount Requested: \$20,000

CORE grant amount: \$20,000

Annual Energy Savings*:

60,897 kWh/ year

Resulting Carbon Savings*:

46.3 tons of carbon per year or 926 tons over the project lifetime, equivalent to taking 177 cars off the road or 76.6 homes off the grid.
